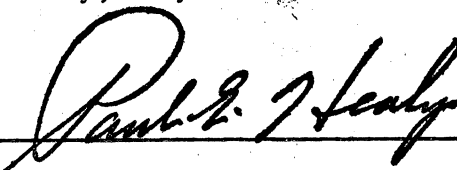

- WHEREAS: On March 29, the more than 1,370,000 members who belong to over 7,300 councils in the United States, Canada, Mexico, the Philippines, Puerto Rico, Guam, Guatemala, Cuba, Canal Zone, Virgin Islands, and the Dominican Republic will observe the anniversary of the granting of the Charter; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That in tribute of the record of the Knights of Columbus on behalf of the Country, Church, Community and fellowmen and in recognition of its contributions in the field of religion, social welfare, civic involvement, youth work and patriotic endeavor, March 29, 1984 is hereby proclaimed as "Knights of Columbus Day" in the City of Cambridge and every official and citizen of Cambridge is urged to take note of and extend congratulations to the Knights of Columbus on its anniversary; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to be presented to the Grand Knight of North Cambridge Council Number 269, Edward R. Sottile, Jr., and to the Grand Knight of Cambridge Council Number 74, T. Albert Darling.
