Investigation by the Department on its own motion into the effect of the reduction in federal income tax rates on the rates charge by electric, telephone, gas and water companies.

On October 22, 1986, the President of the United States signed into law the Tax Reform Act of 1986 which reduces the corporate tax rate from 46 to 34 percent, effective July 1, 1987.

The Department of Public Utilities ("Department") is considering how electric, telephone, gas and water companies under its jurisdiction should pass through to ratepayers any benefits of the decrease in the federal corporate tax rate.

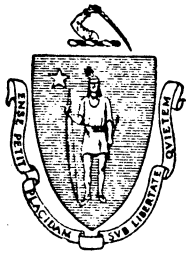

Petition by the Wyman-Gordon Company for the adoption of regulations for reforming and amending the Cost of Gas Adjustment Clause Regulations.

The Department of Public Utilities ("Department") issued revised proposed Cost of Gas Adjustment Clause ("CGAC") regulations on February 9, 1987. The revised proposed CGAC would be seasonal, computed on a semi-annual basis to reflect firm gas costs for a peak and an off peak season.

A copy of the revised proposed Cost of Gas Adjustment Clause regulation is available upon request.

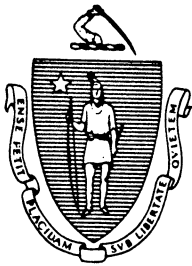

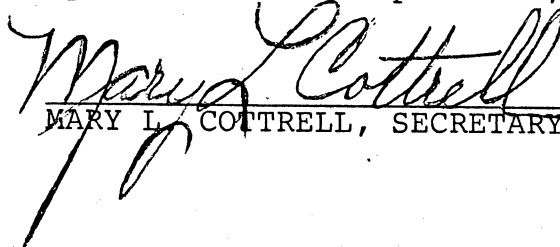
The Department has received an application from NYNEX Paging Company to provide paging service for compensation within the Commonwealth.
