- WHEREAS: On May 28, 1980 the Harvest Restaurant at 44 Brattle Street in Cambridge was held up and robbed of more than \$9,500; and
- WHEREAS: Detectives Joseph Saviole, Timothy McCusker, and Robert Sullivan intercepted a dispatchers message and proceeded to respond to the call immediately following the robbery; and
- WHEREAS: These three detectives apprehended the suspect by anticipating the arrival of the MBTA train from Harvard to Central stations which was used for the "getaway"; and
- WHEREAS: Less than five minutes elapsed from the time of the robbery in Harvard Square to the time of the capture in Central Square; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our deep appreciation and congratulations to Detectives Joseph Saviole, Timothy McCusker, Robert Sullivan and all the men who worked to bring about this arrest; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Detectives Joseph Saviole, Timothy McCusker and Robert Sullivan for their devotion to duty; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Chief of Police be requested to formally extend this Council's appreciation to all the officers both in uniform branch and detective bureau who worked on this case.
