WHEREAS:

A communication has been received from Robert W. Healy, City Manager, transmitting a request from Michael Rosenberg, Assistant City Manager for Community Development and Charles Sullivan, Executive Director of the Cambridge Historical Commission to discontinue as part of the public way a 10 foot wide portion of JFK Street abutting Winthrop Square Park and to accept this portion as part of the Park, with utility easements as required to maintain existing services; and

WHEREAS:

This discontinuance will not affect the traffic flow along JFK Street as two uniform travel lanes will be maintained and the amount of curb parking will not change; and

WHEREAS:

Due notice has been given of this intention of this City Council to discontinue as a public way said portion of JFK Street in the manner prescribed by law and in hearings held before the City Council on June 30, 1986.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED:

That a portion of JFK Street containing 1,328 square feet more or less be and hereby is discontinued as a public way in the City of Cambridge, all as shown on a plan entitled "Proposed Discontinuance of a Part of John F. Kennedy Street." The parcel to be discontinued will become part of the Winthrop Square Park, with utility easements as required to maintain existing services. The aforementioned plan was prepared by Office of City Engineer, City of Cambridge, dated June 13, 1986; and said portion situated between Mt. Auburn and Winthrop Streets, owned by the City of Cambridge, is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point along the southerly line of Mt. Auburn Street at the intersection with the westerly line of John F. Kennedy Street, said point being the most northwesterly corner of the parcel herein described:

Healy, City Manager, transmitting a request from Michael Rosenberg, Assistant City Manager for Community Development and Charles Sullivan, Executive Director of the Cambridge Historical Commission to discontinue as part of the public way a 10 foot wide portion of JFK Street abutting Winthrop Square Park and to accept this portion as part of the Park, with utility easements as required to maintain existing services; and

WHEREAS:

This discontinuance will not affect the traffic flow along JFK Street as two uniform travel lanes will be maintained and the amount of curb parking will not change; and

WHEREAS:

Due notice has been given of this intention of this City Council to discontinue as a public way said portion of Otis Street in the manner prescribed by law and in hearings held before the City Council on June 30, 1986.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED:

That a portion of JFK Street containing 1,328 square feet more or less be and hereby is discontinued as a public way in the City of Cambridge, all as shown on a plan entitled "Proposed Discontinuance of a Part of John F. Kennedy Street as a Vehicular Way, Proposed Acceptance of a Part of John F. Kennedy Street as a Part of Winthrop Square Park", with utility easements as required to maintain existing services, said plan prepared by Office of City Engineer, City of Cambridge, dated June 13, 1986 ; and said portion situated between Mt. Auburn and Winthrop Streets, owned by the City of Cambridge, is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point along the southerly line of Mt. Auburn Street at the intersection with the westerly line of John F. Kennedy Street, said point being the most northwesterly corner of the parcel herein described:

THENCE S 61 11 53 E along said southerly line of Mt. Auburn Street a distance of 10.01 feet to the intersection with the proposed westerly line of John F. Kennedy Street;

THENCE S 31 27 34 W along said proposed westerly line of John F. Kennedy Street a distance of 133.04 feet to the intersection with the northerly line of Winthrop Street;



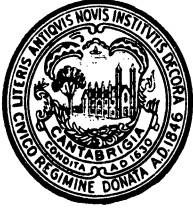

SUBJECT: Winthrop Square Park

Plans are being finalized to improve Winthrop Square Park, at the corner of Mt. Auburn and JFK Streets. Our plans have always included the expansion of the park to recapture from JFK Street an approximately 10-foot strip of land which was originally part of the park. This will not affect operation of the street, because it is 10 feet wider at the park than anywhere else. Therefore, with the extension of the park boundary, there will still be the same number of traffic lanes and parking spaces. In summary, the discontinuance has not only the benefit of adding to park space, but also results in a consistent right-of-way for the full length of JFK Street. Attached is the plan and legal description needed for formal discontinuance of the 10-foot strip as part of the roadway right-of-way, as well as a plan of the design for the park. All relevant City departments have been contacted in regard to this change, and have indicated general support. Any written comments will be transmitted to the Council.

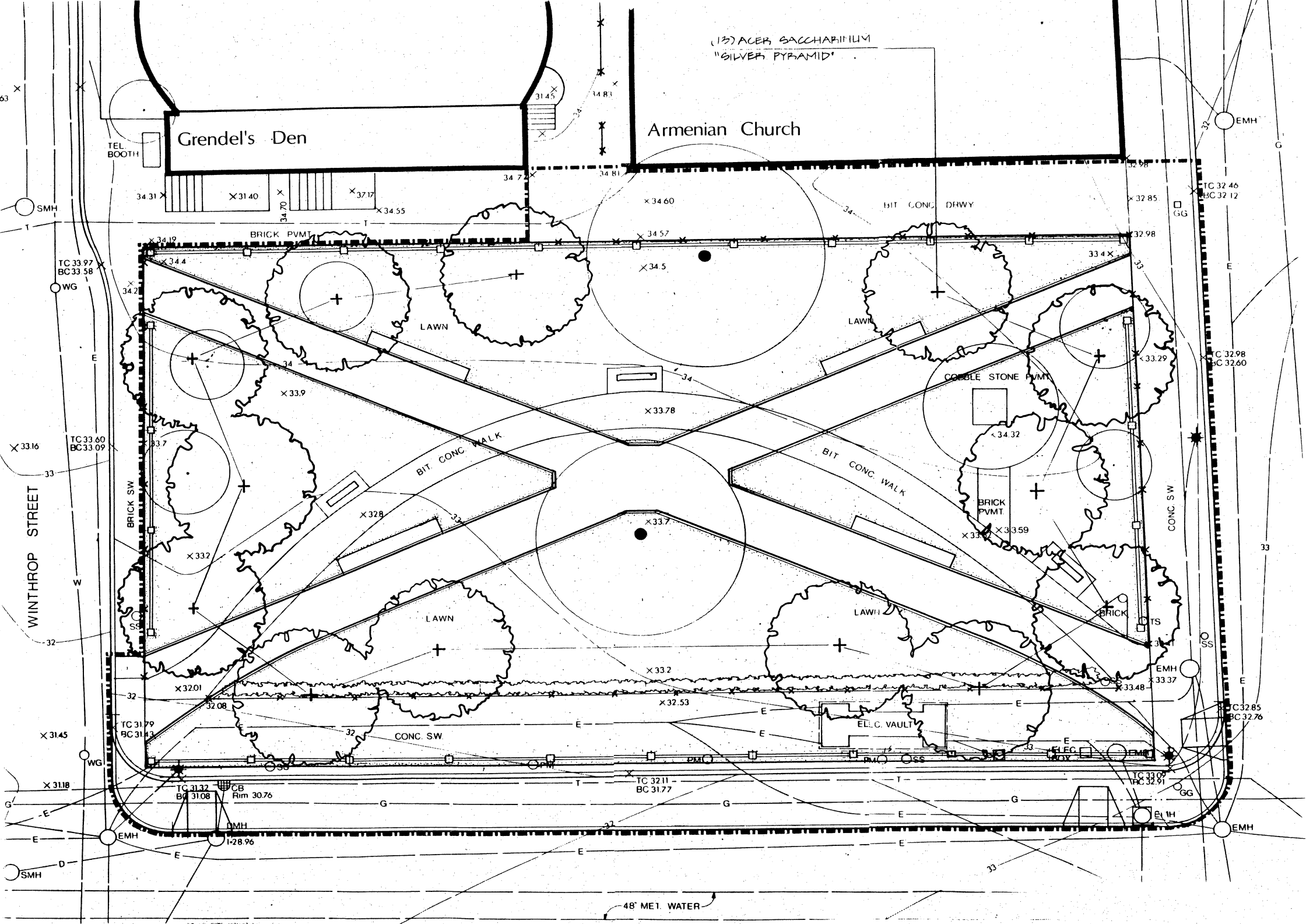
