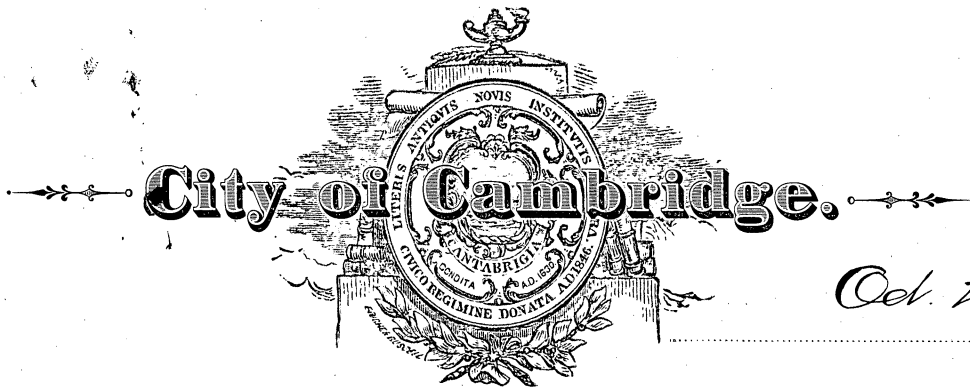
three thousand dollars when the walls of building are up ready to receive the roof,
