I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$334.02 to reimburse John T. Martin, an employee of the Fire Department for damages in this amount.

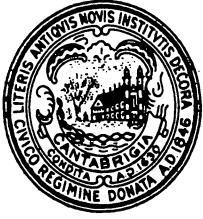
The Law Department, under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against John T. Martin in which there was a judgment of \$334.02.
