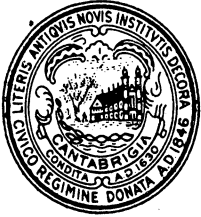
However, the City of Cambridge was notified properly in advance of the hearing and City Clerk, Paul E. Healy, attended the Department public hearing on D.P.U. 948.
