**WHEREAS:** The Finance Department indicates on Page IV-20 of the Annual Budget for 1992-93 that among its achievements it "Improved time and attendance reporting to give department administrators better tools for monitoring sick leave use. Worked with select departments to implement programs for control of excessive absenteeism"; now therefore be it

**ORDERED:** That the City Manager provide the City Council, as soon as possible, with a summary for the years 1990 and 1991 of the use of sick days for the entire City of Cambridge municipal workforce and a breakdown of this total department by department. Further, that same be provided for the first three months of 1992, together with notification as to which departments had been selected for programs to control excessive absenteeism and indicate the degree of verifiable decrease in excessive absenteeism which these monitoring programs have brought about thus far.
