COUNCILLOR WALSH

- WHEREAS: The condition of the vacant lot at the corner of Harvard and Columbia Streets continues to be not only an eyesore but a hazard due to overgrowth extending into the sidewalk and close to adjacent residences, as well as the added presence of trash, refuse and junk including what appear to be stripped parts of mopeds, etc., and despite efforts of some neighbors to remedy the problem a bit, it continues to fester with the apparent indifference or approval of the property's owner whose identity is not certain; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager direct the appropriate City departmental personnel to take the necessary steps to clean up the lot in question and, if applicable, apply and enforce, to its full extent, Section 8.24.260 of the Cambridge Municipal Code regarding the presence of Rubbish, Garbage and Litter; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to this City Council by September 25, 1989 to confirm that the problem has been solved and the work has been completed.
