Petition of Boston and Maine Railroad for authority under the provisions of Section 128 of Chapter 160 of the General Laws of Massachusetts (Ter. Ed.) to abandon the passenger station and to discontinue train service at the West Cambridge station in the City of Cambridge.

Upon the foregoing petition the Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing at its hearing room, 166 State House, Boston, on Monday, the 16th day of April, 1951, at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon.

And the petitioner is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once at least 14 days prior to said date in the Cambridge Sentinel and by posting a copy hereof on said station building for a period of 30 days immediately preceding day of hearing and to serve a copy hereof by registered mail at least 14 days prior to said date on the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Cambridge, and to make return of service and publication at the time of hearing.


