That the City Council go on record enthusiastically supporting the recent decision of the Supreme Court of the United States which approved bussing and limited racial balancing as legitimate ways of assuring that black children receive an integrated education and struck a decisive blow against segregation by law in the areas covered by the court decision, and be it further

ORDERED:-

That the City Clerk be and hereby is directed to send a copy of this order to the Supreme Court in Washington to record the approval of this City Council on their decision with the further hope that future decisions of the court will provide means of eliminating segregated schools throughout the United States.
