Dr. John C. McGirr served his residency in surgery at the Boston City Hospital and was a practicing surgeon in the City of Cambridge since 1939 and rose to the position of Senior Surgeon on the staff of the Cambridge City Hospital and the Sancta Maria Hospital, and

Dr. John C. McGirr served his country in the Medical Corps in World War II and was a fellow of the American College of Surgeons and a member of the American Medical Association and an active member of the Massachusetts Medical Society and the Middlesex Medical Society, be it
