In City Council,

WHEREAS:-

The making, emitting, and transmitting of loud and raucous noises upon or over public places seriously interferes with the rights of persons to peaceful enjoyment of private property, and seriously interferes with travel and safety of persons using the public ways or otherwise present in public places, now, therefore be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:-

It shall be unlawful for any person, group of persons, corporation or other entities, to hold any meetings, concerts, or other open air event on public property at which amplification of sound by any device is of such volume, intensity or carrying power as to tend to interfere with the peace and quiet of other persons on public or private property or using public ways. Any person, group of persons, corporation, or other entity violating this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars for each offense.
