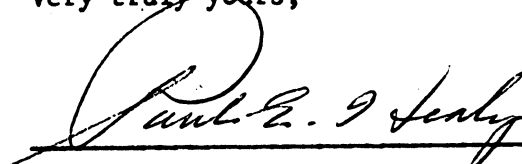
Dear Mr. Armistead:

WHEREAS:

A broad coalition of Harvard students, faculty, and alumni have come together to solicit contributions to the Endowment for Divestiture in order to encourage Harvard to adopt a policy of divestiture; therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That the Cambridge City Council declare its support for this effort and encourage all alumni of the University to contribute to Harvard through the Endowment for Divestiture; and be it further

RESOLVED:

That the City Clerk send a copy of this resolution to Harvard University, to the Harvard Club of Boston, and to any other appropriate local organizations of Harvard alumni.
