So help me God.

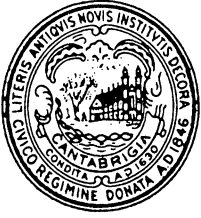


