COUNCILLOR D. SULLIVAN

- WHEREAS: The Mid-Cambridge Neighborhood Association, at its meeting of March 24, noted the worsening traffic problems in that neighborhood; and
- WHEREAS: Much of the increase in traffic can be attributed to new office developments in Kendall Square, and additional office developments are planned there and on Massachusetts Avenue; and
- WHEREAS: Additional traffic generated by these new office developments seems likely to increase noise, pollution, and traffic on Broadway, Cambridge, Prospect, Inman, Antrim, Inman, Fayette, Trowbridge, and similar streets; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager direct the Community Development and Traffic Departments, in conjunction with the residents of Mid-Cambridge, to study these traffic problems, determine the causes of increased traffic, recommend ways of controlling this traffic, and develop a plan of action for traffic control; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager transmit the results of this study to the City Council not later than June 27, 1983.
