I respectfully request that the amount of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) be appropriated to Police B-14 Account, Motor vehicle, repairs and care.

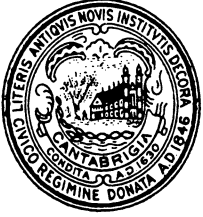
This amount is necessary at this time in order that we may be able to pay for outside repairs to all of our police vehicles.
