COUNCILLOR WALSH

WHEREAS: A good number of complaints have been received from taxpayers that when they go to City Hall they are not able to find a place to park while they run in to pay their tax bills, and often receive a parking ticket; and

WHEREAS: Since the City Council parking space does not require full-time use during the work week; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager take immediate steps to notify the residents of Cambridge as well as the appropriate personnel at both the Police Department and the Department of Traffic and Parking, that, effective immediately, the Council parking space and a space designated by the City Manager at the City Hall Annex will be available for the next sixty (60) days during the work week if residents are going to be doing business in City Hall for 15 minutes or less; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to review this proposal and report back to this City Council with his findings at the City Council meeting of May 7, 1990.
