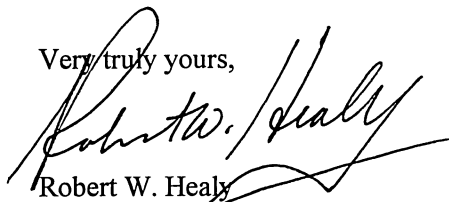
To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$9,000 in private donations to the Grant Fund Department of Public Works Other Ordinary Maintenance account to support enhanced maintenance at two City parks. These donations were made as part of the City's new *Adopt-A-Park* program.

Central Square LLC has donated \$3,000 for annual flower planting at Carl Barron Plaza, located at the corner of Massachusetts Avenue and Magazine Street, for a one year period. In addition to this financial contribution, Central Square LLC will be providing enhanced maintenance to this area to augment the City's efforts in litter pickup, pavement sweeping and steam cleaning of the pavement.

Cambridge Savings Bank has donated \$6,000 for enhanced maintenance at Dawes Island, located at the intersection of Garden Street and Massachusetts Avenue for a one year period. These funds will be used to supplement the regular park maintenance program, including additional plantings and maintenance/watering of the planting area, pruning of shrubs and trees and sweeping the pavement.
