Dear Mr. Sullivan:

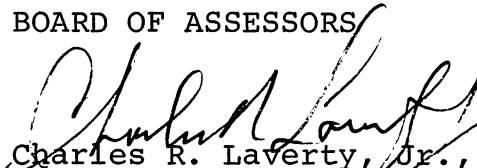
Please be advised that we have met with the proper authorities of Harvard University relative to the above matter and have been assured that there is no financial gain on the part of the University.

A letter from Harvard University is enclosed affirming same.

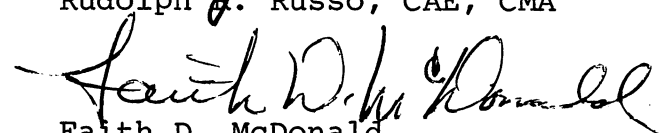
We had a lengthy meeting in our office and asked many questions concerning this matter, and the facts as presented indicated that there should be no change in the tax status.

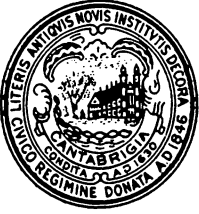

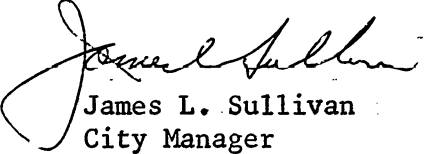
