- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Mary C. Supple, former language teacher at Cambridge High and Latin School; and
- WHEREAS: Mary was graduated from local public schools and received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Radcliffe College in 1921 and in 1933 received a Master of Arts degree from Catholic University; and
- WHEREAS: Mary first began her teaching career in the Cambridge Public School system as a substitute teacher in September of 1921 and worked as a permanent substitute until her appointment as a permanent teacher in September of 1923, assigned to the Language Department at Cambridge High and Latin School, remaining there until her retirement in June of 1965; and
- WHEREAS: Mary was an individual who truly enjoyed the teaching profession and who took great pleasure in nurturing her students in the art of learning a second language; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Ms. Agnes Supple, Mary's sister and the Supple family at this time of personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Agnes Supple on behalf of the entire City Council.
