In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and  
Seventy Five,

An Ordinance in amendment of the Ordinance  
in relation to Deeds,

Be it ordained by the City Council of the  
City of Cambridge, as follows,

Chapter 7 of the Revised Ordinances is hereby  
amended by adding thereto the following,

Section 3. Whenever the owner of any land sold to  
the City for the nonpayment of assessments for  
the construction of sewers or sidewalks, for  
filling lands to grade under the Low Land  
Acts, or for benefits caused by the laying out,  
altering, widening, grading or discontinuing of a  
street under the Betterment Act, shall within  
two years from the day of the sale pay to the  
City Treasurer the sum for which the land  
was sold to the City, with ten per centum interest  
thereon and all necessary intervening charges, the  
City Treasurer shall certify the same to the Mayor,  
who shall thereupon, on behalf of the City, execute, ac-  
knowledge and deliver such a deed as may be nec-  
essary to release whatever interest the City acquired  
by the sale.
