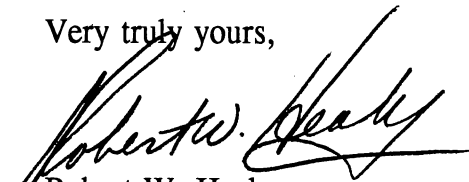

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$402,600.00 in the general fund of the Cambridge Fire Department from the Salary and Wages Account to the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. The funds will be used to purchase new protective clothing for 244 fire fighter at a cost of \$1,650.00 per set. Each set includes one coat, two sets of trousers/suspenders and two sets of boots. These new suits will allow Cambridge to meet all accepted standards including the National Fire Protection Association 1500, **Standard on Fire Department Occupational Safety and Health Program.**
