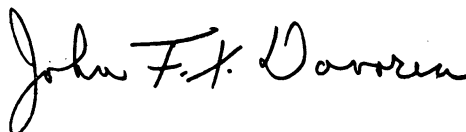

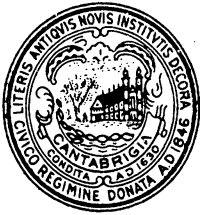

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

1. To provide charitable legal services to those in need in areas of law which promote equality between the sexes; and primarily to women^{who} suffer discrimination because of their sex.
2. To maintain an office where such services may be rendered, and from time to time, to publish such legal educational materials which will explain to lay persons channels they may utilize to redress grievances.
3. To carry on any other charitable or educational function permitted by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to a non-profit corporation organized under Chapter 180. The aforementioned powers are in furtherance of but not in limitation of the general powers conferred by Chapter 180 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts as amended and as further limited by the exempt purposes set forth in Section 501 (c) (3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code as amended.

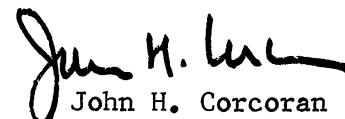
