- WHEREAS: Mrs. Epps was the oldest member of the Columbus Avenue A.M.E. Church; member of the church's Stewardship Committee; John W. Williams Club; Maryland Club; and the Sadie Thornehill Usher Board; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathies to the family of Mary Epps; and be it further
