WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that the Cambridge Fire Department responded to a call on the morning of September 27, 1985 with swiftness and expertise that deserve special recognition; and

WHEREAS: At approximately 4:00 AM on the 27th an alarm was sounded for a fire at the premises of 72 1/2 Inman Street where the responding firefighters arrived to find a garage fire and a house fire occurring simultaneously; and

WHEREAS: The firefighters swift response brought the garage fire under control quickly whereupon they turned their attention to the fire that had begun behind the aluminum siding of the house; and

WHEREAS: The firefighters were able to quickly douse that fire by chopping through a wall against which was stacked a stereo and rare books worth thousands of dollars during which time they demonstrated great dexterity and consideration so that virtually no damage came to these valuable items; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council do hereby commend Deputy Chief Stanley Kotowski, Captain Thomas Stack, Captain Robert Kotowski, Firefighters Robert Dahl, Ronald Ring, William McGovern, Daniel Flaherty, Rodger Johnson, Edmund Gildea, Frank Wolk, and Probationary Firefighters Dennis Shine and Gregory Carter for the highest degree of competence and professionalism that they displayed on the morning of September 27, 1985; and be it further
