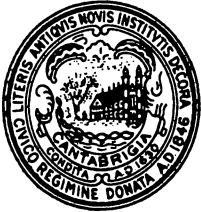



To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached are two orders concerning the financial problems of the Cambridge School Department. The first order declares that an extreme emergency involving the health and safety of the school children in this City exists and as such the School Department would be authorized to exceed their appropriation by \$919,000. The emergency which would be declared in accordance with Chapter 44, Sec. 31, of the General Laws requires an affirmative vote of 6 votes of the City Council as well as the approval of the Director of Accounts.

The second order is necessary in order to comply with Chapter 151 of the Acts of 1979, better known as the "Tax Cap". When the final tax cap forms were submitted to the State's Bureau of Accounts for approval last September, they showed that the City was \$599,280.01 under the appropriation limit. Since that time there has been \$318,570 in relevant supplemental appropriations which has brought the City to within \$280,710.01 of the appropriation limit. Thus, if the City Council authorizes the School Department to spend \$919,000 in excess of its appropriation, the appropriation limit will be exceeded by \$638,289.99. As with the first order, this order requires an affirmative vote of six members of the City Council.
