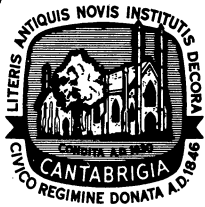

Dear Councillor

It has been brought to my attention that applications have already been made to the City Council for the position of City Auditor, Comptroller and Director of Finance now held by Mr. Martin F. Nolan. I have heard unofficially that there will be a vacancy in this position because of the retirement of Mr. Nolan.

If, and only if Mr. Nolan is retiring, I would like your consideration for this position. Briefly, my qualifications and background are as follows:

Born in Cambridge on May 21, 1917 and graduated from the Peabody Grammar School and Cambridge High and Latin School.

Graduated from the Bentley School of Accounting and Finance (now Bentley College) in the class of 1940 - Evening Division.

Went to work for Rival Foods, Inc., Wholesale Grocers of 38 Henry Street, Cambridge directly from high school in 1935. I held the position of Comptroller for the 5 years prior to their liquidation.

Since September of 1952 have held the position of Business Agent for the Public Works Department of the City of Cambridge working with Mr. Ralph J. Dunphy, Commissioner of Public Works. This is being written with the knowledge and consent of Mr. Dunphy.

During World War II... I served in the United States Navy in the Pacific Theatre.

As stated, this is only a brief outline and I will be only too happy to give you more information in detail, via any means you may desire.

Again I ask your consideration, as I feel that I have the necessary qualifications and desire to be an asset to the City of Cambridge in this capacity as I believe that I have been for the past sixteen years in the Public Works Department.
