WHEREAS: A trained and knowledgeable citizenry can provide personal and family survival measures prior to government assistance; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this Cambridge City Council does hereby proclaim May 8, 1994 as Emergency Responders Memorial Day and the week of May 8-14th, 1994 as Emergency Management Week throughout the City of Cambridge.
