IN CITY COUNCIL

ORDERED: That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Harvard Law School to erect twelve temporary banners on street light poles at 1511 Massachusetts Avenue to Everett Street (east side of Massachusetts Avenue only), Cambridge, Massachusetts.

Provided that, before erecting the above named temporary banners the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department and file with the City Clerk a bond in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) dollars, conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the installation, maintenance and use of said twelve temporary banners.

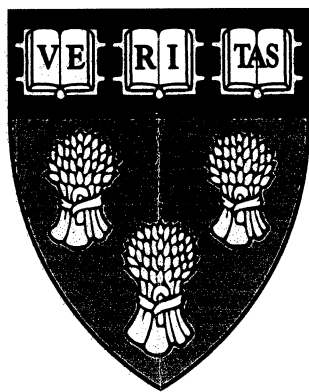

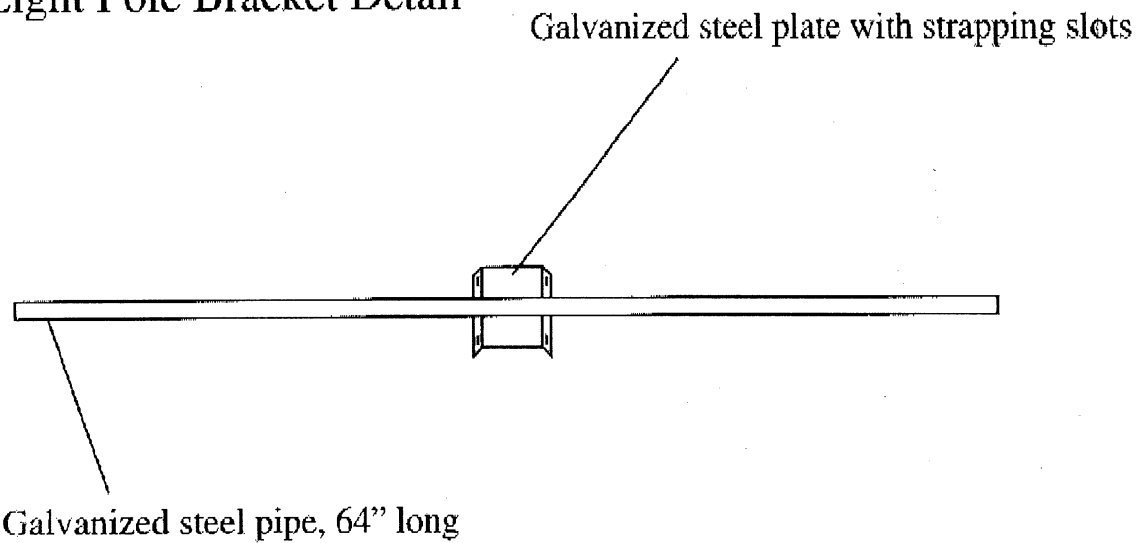

The weight of each 30"x60" double sided vinyl light pole banner is about 2.5 pounds.

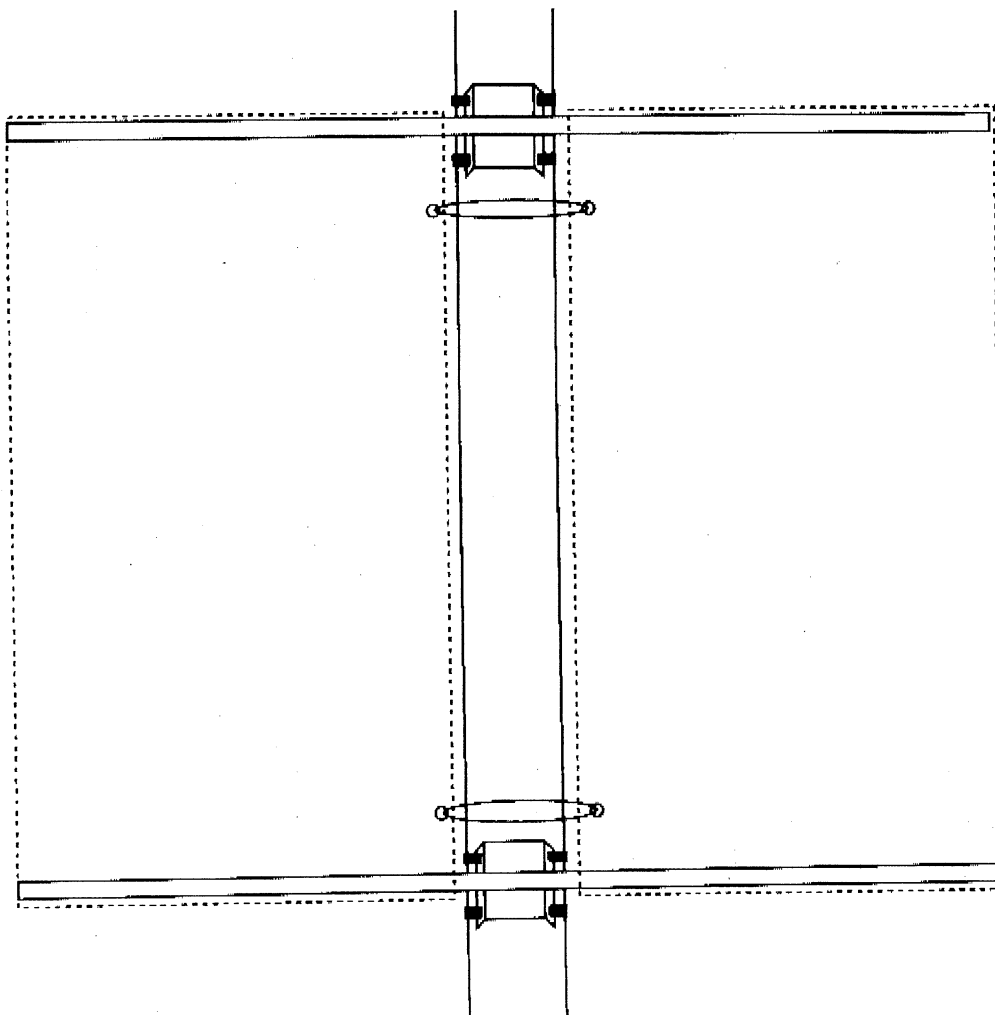

I am writing to request the use of 12 light poles on Massachusetts Avenue in Cambridge that are the property of NStar. The poles are on the east side of Mass Ave. between the bus terminal and Everett Street. Their identification numbers are #156, 158, 160, 162, 164, 166, 168, 170, 172, 174, 176, and 178. The poles would be used to hang celebratory banners for the kick-off of an upcoming Harvard Law School campaign, *Setting the Standard: The Harvard Law School Campaign*.

The flags will be produced by Heritage Flag Company in South Boston. Heritage Flag will also be providing the hardware to attach the banners to the poles. Heritage has provided a description of the hardware, which follows as a separate attachment. The banners will be hung from approximately June 10 through June 20, 2003.

It is my understanding that if the above meets with your approval, a document prepared by your legal department detailing this agreement will be sent here for signing.

RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT made this 28 day of May, 2003, by and between the Harvard Law School, with its principal place of business located at the Harvard Law School Alumni Center, Cambridge, Massachusetts (hereinafter referred to as "Harvard"), and CAMBRIDGE ELECTRIC LIGHT COMPANY D/B/A NSTAR ELECTRIC COMPANY, a Massachusetts corporation having its principal place of business at 800 Boylston Street, Boston, Massachusetts (hereinafter referred to as "NSTAR Electric").

WHEREAS, Harvard has requested NSTAR Electric to grant it permission to place and maintain banners on twelve (12) poles located on the east side of Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge, MA (Poles 156, 158, 160, 162, 164, 166, 168, 170, 172, 174, 176, and 178) from June 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 in the manner as shown on the Attachment A (hereinafter referred to as "Harvard's Attachments"), and

WHEREAS, NSTAR Electric has granted to do so, in consideration thereof Harvard agrees as follows:

1. Harvard hereby releases NSTAR Electric from all actions, suits, claims and demands which Harvard may hereafter have, whether arising out of tort or otherwise, which arise out of or result from any actions related to the erection, maintenance, presence, use or removal of Harvard's Attachments or by their proximity to the facilities of other parties attached to NSTAR Electric's poles.

2. Harvard hereby promises to defend, indemnify and hold NSTAR Electric harmless from and against any and all liability, losses, damage or expenses which NSTAR Electric may incur as a result of any action, suit, claim, demand or judgment against NSTAR Electric arising out of or as a result of any actions related to the erection, maintenance, presence, use or removal of Harvard's Attachments or by their proximity to the facilities of other parties attached to NSTAR Electric's poles.

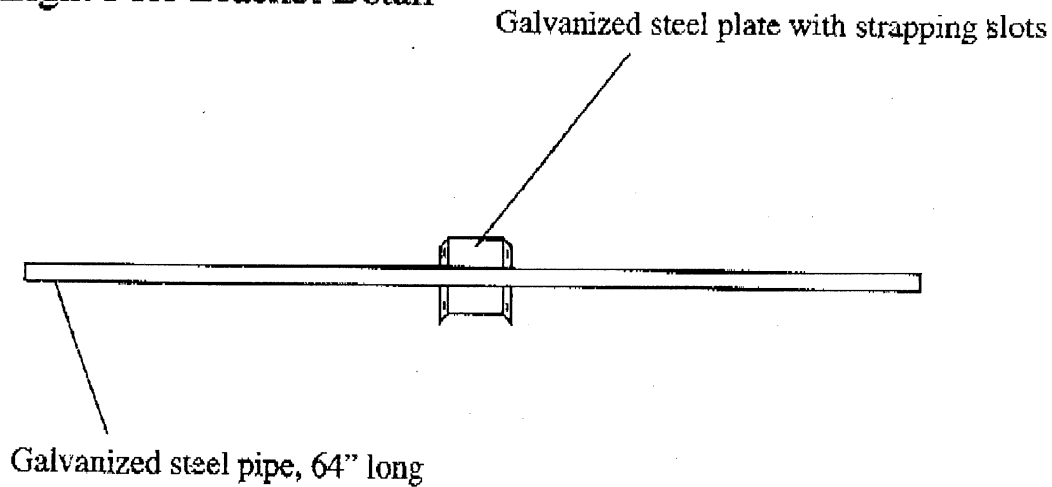

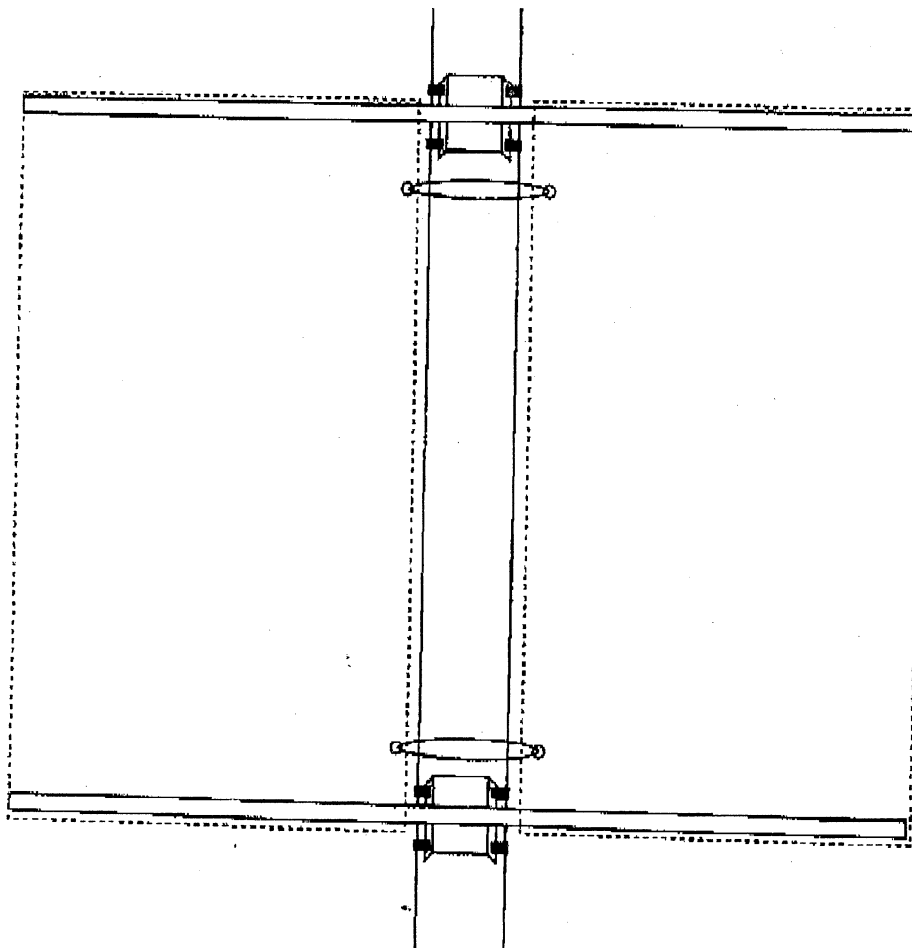
