- WHEREAS: Eva is a nationally recognized expert and advocate on immigration law and policy. She has worked toward comprehensive immigration legislation and administrative reforms. Her analysis guides advocacy groups across the country and is particularly pointed on the need for the reform of immigration laws; and
- WHEREAS: For the last eight years, she has served as the co-chair of the Governor's Advisory Council on Refugees and Immigrants; now therefore be it
