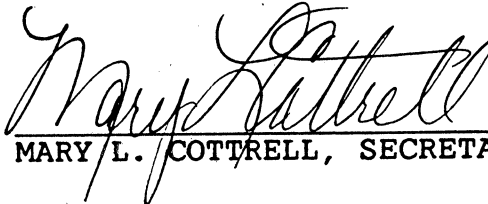
The above investigation is officially captioned:
