- WHEREAS: In mid August when good news was in short supply, a message of good news was contained in a letter I received from Joshua T. Anderson of T. H. Reenstierna and Sons, a tenant at One Kendall Square, which applauded the rapid and effective response of Cambridge Fire Department personnel to a fire on the third floor at One Kendall Square; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Anderson summed it up succinctly when he wrote, "I thought that in these times of so much bad news of tragedies, some good news of a tragedy averted by the outstanding performance of the Cambridge Fire Department would be welcome;" now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council takes the occasion of this referenced letter to congratulate Fire Chief Thomas Scott and Fire Department personnel who did in this instance what we have come to expect and sometimes tend to take for granted, their customary excellent work; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution and transmit same to Chief Scott with our request that he make this resolution available to and share it with the Fire Department personnel who responded to the One Kendall Square alarm.
