2. Signs will be erected on Mt. Auburn St. and Homer Ave. directing motorists to the parking lot.

I have enclosed a sketch of the area showing the approximate location of the signs and gate. Also, attached is a copy of Mr. Moffatt's letter.

Dear Mr. Preston,

We have now completed Star's portion of the work which you and I discussed late last Fall in connection with control of traffic in the Aberdeen Avenue/Homer Avenue section of Mt. Auburn Street. We have installed a gate stopping passage on the right of way from our parking lot to Aberdeen Avenue and have erected the necessary signs to direct people to the Homer Avenue access. This gate is closed and locked between the hours of 7 PM and 7 AM nightly.

I met briefly with Mr. Philip Leccese of your department, and reviewed the necessity for and location of signs to be placed on Mt. Auburn Street in front of the buildings at number 625. To be legally effective these signs must be installed at the direction of your department. We await their erection and the subsequent enforcement of the no parking zone which currently exists from the corner of Aberdeen Avenue to a point beyond Homer Avenue.

As I understand it this will complete both sides of our agreement. Please let me know if there are any further steps which Star can take which will benefit the situation.

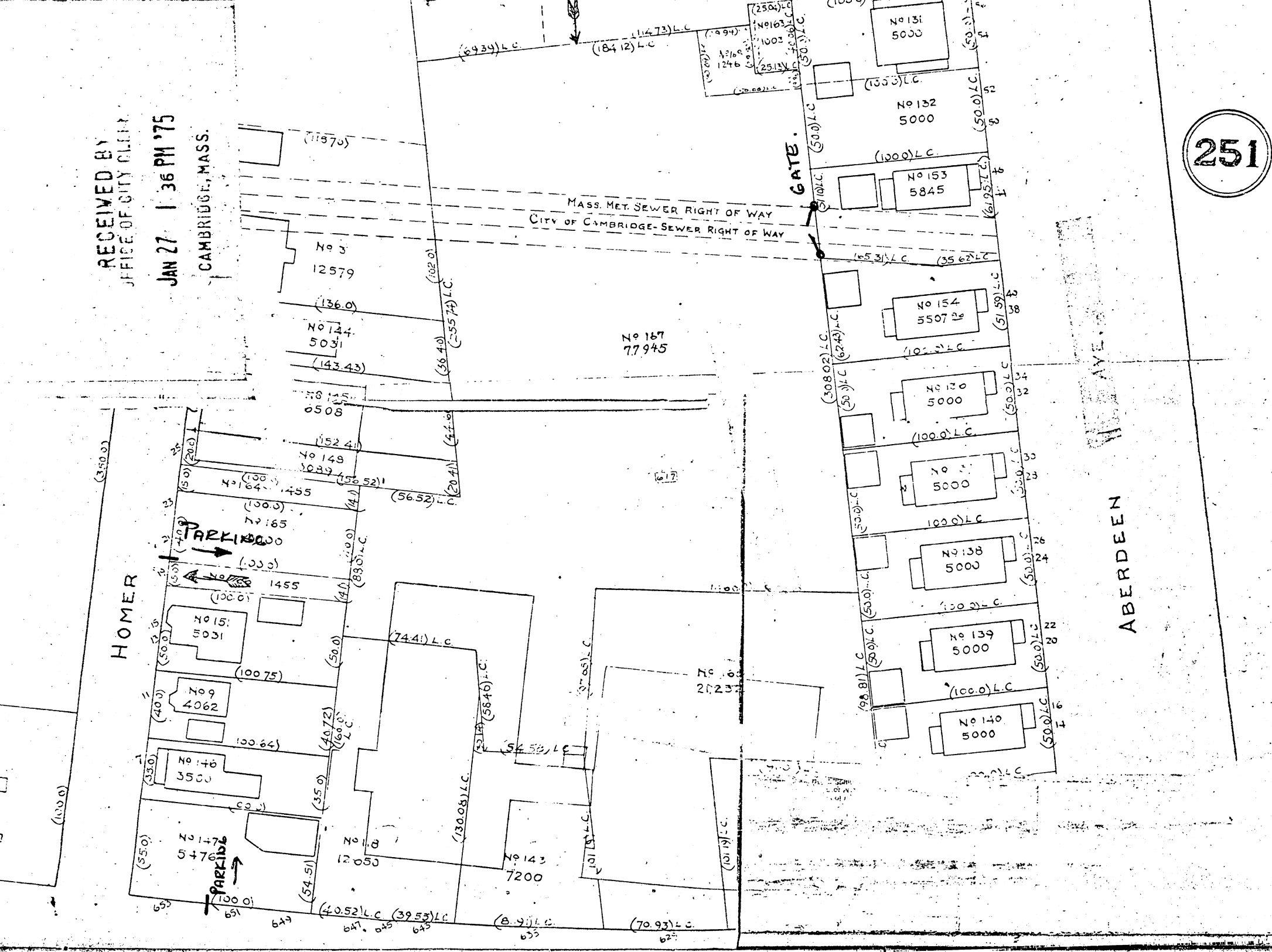
