In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 01-167, regarding a report on the possibility of expanding the police bicycle patrol, Police Commissioner Ronnie Watson:

There are no plans to expand the Bicycle Patrol Unit (BPU) beyond the ten sworn officers currently regularly assigned. However, in order to maintain adequate coverage during vacation periods, mandatory in-service training, etc., three (3) additional officers are being trained and outfitted. They will be available for temporary assignment to the BPU as needed.
