WHEREAS: It is fitting that the City of Cambridge should join with the National Organization on Disability in calling for the support and involvement of citizens in the nationwide "Calling on American" campaign; and

WHEREAS: July 26, 1991, has been proclaimed "Calling on America" day in Massachusetts; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council urge the members of our community to take cognizance of this event, participate fully in its observance, and renew their commitment to and support for people with disabilities in Cambridge and nationwide.
