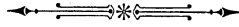

Saunders et al for Edge stone and Buck sidewalk on the northerly side of the street leading from Smith Avenue at corner of Wolines Place, to Kirkland Street, (The entire cost of such material used have to be borne by the City, and no such work was contemplated in making the appropriation for paving at the beginning of the year)
