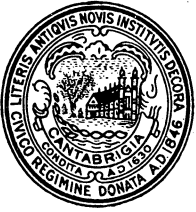

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$3,600.00 to reimburse Gustave A. Kuhn, an employee of the Fire Department for damages in this amount.

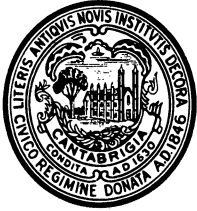
