WHEREAS:

Notice has been received of the death of William J. Cunningham, a life-long resident of our city and superintendent of the Cambridge Postoffice, it is fitting that we should express our appreciation of his long and faithful service to the Federal Government.

Mr. Cunningham was born in Cambridge in 1858. Upon his graduation from school he entered the employ of the Charles River Railroad and, after a period of two years with that Company, left to enter the service of the United States Government in the postal department. From 1884 up to the time of his death he held many positions of trust in the postal service, being superintendent of the Cambridge Station at Harvard Square since 1925.

He gave willingly of his time and talents. He gained and held the respect and admiration of the people he served and, by the faithful adherence to the manifold duties assigned him, has left a record that should serve as an inspiration to the youth of our city. It is therefore

That the City Council hereby extends its sincere sympathy to the family of William J. Cunningham and that a copy of these resolutions be spread upon the records of the City Council.
