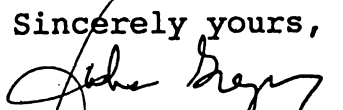
Dear Councillors Myers and Duehay:

I was pleased to learn that the matter of the Windsor, Market and Harvard St. apartments which Councillor Duehay referred to the Sub-Committee on Rent Control is scheduled to be addressed at the sub-committee meeting on July 14th. As you know we are anxious to bring additional testimony before the City Council regarding the issue of high rents and deplorable housing conditions which appear to exist in properties primarily owned by large landlords. This issue is of major importance to the citizens of Cambridge, and we urge that the sub-committee hearing be telecast that the information which will be presented is available to a broader audience that might be in attendance at the sub-committee meeting.

It had been the intention of the Eviction Free Zone when we first presented this matter to the City Council on February 3rd to urge that a public hearing be held to address this issue. We have no problem with the sub-committee's addressing the issue as long as the hearing is telecast.

If the sub-committee meeting cannot be accessible through municipal television, then on behalf of the Eviction Free Zone we request that Councillor Duehay re-direct his order so that the matter is brought before the entire council at one of its regular city council meetings.

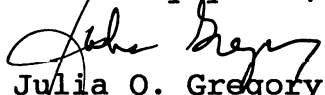
