CITY OF CAMBRIDGE
In the Year One Thousand,
Nine Hundred and Seventy-four
AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to an ordinance
formerly entitled: "The General
Ordinances of the City of Cam-
bridge" as revised in 1972 and now
designated as "The Code of the City
of Cambridge."

Be it ordained by the City Council
of the City of Cambridge as follows:

The Code of the City of Cam-
bridge are hereby amended by
adding at the end thereof of Chapter
2 entitled: "Administration" the
following new Article XXVII en-
titled: "Assistant City Manager for
Fiscal Affairs."

**ARTICLE XXVII ASSISTANT
CITY MANAGER FOR FISCAL
AFFAIRS.**

**Section 2-227. Composition of
Division.**

The Division of Finance shall
consist of the Auditing Department,
Assessors Department, Budget and
Personnel Department, Purchasing
Department and Treasury
Department.

**Section 2-228. Assistant City
Manager for Fiscal Affairs Heads
Division.**

The Division of Finance shall be
under the control of the Assistant
City Manager for Fiscal Affairs,
who shall be the Director of
Finance, and who shall be con-
sidered a department head within
the provisions of General Laws of
the Commonwealth of
Massachusetts Chapter 43, Section
103.

**Section 2-229. Director in Charge
of Division.**

The Director of Finance shall be
in charge of the Division of
Finance.

**Section 2-230. Appointment and
Term of Assistant City Manager for
Fiscal Affairs.**

The Assistant City Manager for
Fiscal Affairs shall be appointed by
and serve at the pleasure of the City
Manager. It is the intention of this
provision to fix all responsibility
and vest all authority for the ap-
pointment and removal of the
Assistant City Manager for Fiscal
Affairs in the City Manager.

**Section 2-231. No Civil Service or
Tenure Rights.**

The Assistant City Manager for
Fiscal Affairs shall have no rights
under Civil Service, nor acquire
any rights of tenure in any manner.

**Section 2-232. Power and Duties
of Assistant City Manager for
Fiscal Affairs.**

The powers and duties of the
Assistant City Manager for Fiscal
Affairs shall be such as are
designated and assigned from time
to time to the Assistant City
Manager for Fiscal Affairs by the
City Manager. The Assistant City
Manager for Fiscal Affairs shall
have all the powers, rights and
duties that the City Manager shall
determine as are necessary for the
proper functioning and general
effectiveness, as well as for the
general supervision and control, of
the departments, divisions, boards,
agencies, commissions, and of-
ficers, consistent with the powers
and duties assigned to him by the
City Manager.

**Section 2-233. Compensation for
Assistant City Manager for Fiscal
Affairs.**

The Assistant City Manager for
Fiscal Affairs shall receive as
annual compensation the same
amount set forth in Section 2-191 of
this Chapter for Assistant City
Manager.

**Section 2-234. Auditor as Com-
ptroller of Accdunts.**

The City Auditor shall be com-
ptroller of accounts and none of the
preceding sections effect those
powers and duties which are the
responsibility of the City Auditor by
Statute.

This ordinance shall take effect
July 1, 1974.
