WHEREAS: Information has been received that Massachusetts Institute of Technology is planning to own and operate its own generator for electricity, which would supply the power for its facilities; and

WHEREAS: Removing MIT as customers of Com Energy will force the price of electricity to be spread over the remaining consumers of the City of Cambridge, thereby causing hardship to already hard pressed customers who are paying higher rates for water bills, property taxes, etc.; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the proper city departments, Community Development, Consumers Council etc, to monitor the situation; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Council go on record as urging MIT to re-think their position on this issue, and consider the citizens of Cambridge in whatever decision they may make.
