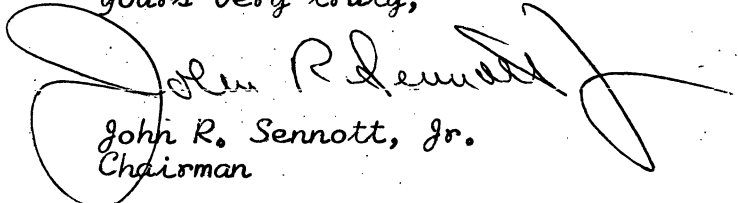
Dear Mr. Sprague:

In reference to the alleged noise by trucks during early hours complained about by Mrs. Margaret Spera of 12 Sciarappa Street and residents in the vicinity against Fernando Fernandes concerning his Open Air Parking Lot at 239 Msgr. O'Brien Highway, the License Commission summoned Mr. Fernandes to appear before its public hearing on Tuesday, April 6, 1971. Mr. Fernandes was cautioned to see that the trucks discontinue noise between the hours of 4:00 A.M. and 6:30 A.M. He stated that no trucks actually left the lot until 6:00 A.M. or thereafter but will warn all truck operators of the feeling of the Board in this matter.

Mr. Fernandes was told that if there were any further reliable complaints, he will have to answer to the Board for the same. The Board took cognizance of the fact that this is a noisy area in any event.
