WHEREAS: This day, "Veterans' Day," is a day on which we join cities and towns across the nation to salute locally the millions of Americans who are also who are veterans; and

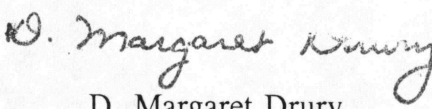
