Southern Pacific Telecommunications Company d/b/a SP Telecom ("Applicant"), a corporation under Delaware laws, has applied to the Department of Public Utilities for authority to provide telecommunications services to businesses within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The Applicant proposes to offer direct dialed 1+, 800, dedicated private line, WATS, and travel card services to business customers statewide.

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This investigation is officially captioned:

Application of Southern Pacific Telecommunications Company d/b/a SP Telecom under the provisions of chapter 159 of the General Laws, as amended, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a resale, value-added or inter-exchange common carrier within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Comments, objections and requests for a public hearing on the proposed service must be made in writing with specific reasons for requesting a public hearing, and filed with the Secretary of the Department on or before February 4, 1994.

The petitioner, Southern Pacific Telecommunications Company d/b/a SP Telecom, is required to complete the following: (1) Give notice by publication hereof once, on or before January 21, 1994. [which is twenty-one (21) days prior to February 11, 1994] in the Boston Globe, Morning Union (Springfield), Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield), Worcester Telegram; (2) Give notice by mailing a copy hereof on or before January 21, 1994 to the Local Exchange and Other Common Carriers on the attached Interexchange Carriers list; and (3) Make return of service and publication no later than February 18, 1994.
