

**Subject** State Grant Offer for Leak Detection & Water System Rehabilitation

Please find attached two grant offer and acceptance forms for State funding under the "Leak Detection and System Rehabilitation Program." The State funding available to the Water Dept. on a 50/50 matching grant basis is:

LEAK DETECTION: \$ 21,346.76

REHABILITATION: \$318,250.00

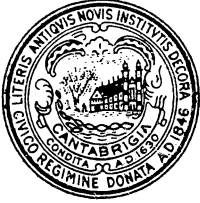
This leak detection grant will be supplemented with another State grant of \$3,653.24 (accepted by City Council at the September 27th session) for a sub-total of \$25,000 State funding that will match the \$25,000 Water Dept. share already appropriated in the Fiscal Year 1982-83 budget as a capital improvement special project.

The rehabilitation grant will be used to match Water Dept. funds previously expended from the Fiscal Year 1980-81 budget and other projects now under construction. The actual match-up of State funding and Water Dept. funding will be dependent upon the post-job audits of the water main construction work already completed. Any surplus of State funding from this grant can be matched by the City in Fiscal Year 1983-84.

The attached grant offer forms should be accepted by the City Council at the December 6th session and then designated to the Water Dept. special project account.
