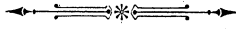

-Reports-

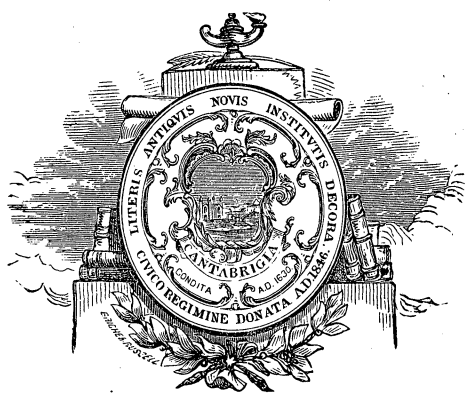

July 2 1883

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

*Norris Street, so-called
from North Avenue to Cedar Street*

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land

in width between *North Avenue and
Cedar Street,*

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *Ed. Tucker Howe,*
dated May 17, 1883

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *the*
several owners and abutters having waived the usual
notice of such taking, and released said land to
the city.
