PRESS RELEASE IMMEDIATELY:

Mr. John H. Corcoran, City Manager, today signed an agreement between the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Public Works and the City of Cambridge, whereas, the City of Cambridge under the jurisdiction of the Traffic and Parking Department will install traffic control devices at the following five intersections:

1. Massachusetts Avenue and Inman Street
2. Broadway and Inman Street
3. Broadway and Prospect Street
4. Cambridge Street and Prospect Street
5. Hampshire Street and Prospect Street

Upon completion of the five intersections, the State Department of Public Works will reimburse the City of Cambridge under the provisions of Chapter 519, Acts of 1967 and Chapter 90, Section 33B of the General Laws ter. ed., 75% of the total cost of these projects. This will amount to a total of \$80,000.00 savings to the City of Cambridge. The work on these intersections will be started on August 25, 1970.
