- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Peter Lucarelli, a former long term Cambridge resident and retired Metropolitan Police Officer; and
- WHEREAS: Peter, a Cambridge native, attended local public schools and was active in civic and fraternal organizations in both Cambridge and Somerville, having been a founder and past President of the Cambridge Warren Pals Association and served as a member of the Somerville Recreation Commission; and
- WHEREAS: Peter was a Mounted Division Police Officer for the Metropolitan District Commission for many years prior to his retirement in 1954 and after retirement, served in various administrative capacities in State government, holding such positions as Chief Secretary to former Attorney General George Fingold, as well as serving as an Administrative Aide to former State Senate President John E. Powers and Moris A. Donahue; and
- WHEREAS: Peter served his country well during World War II as a member of the United States Army and remained active in veteran affairs as a member of American Legion Post No. 19 of Somerville; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to his wife, Mrs. Mary (Bertocci) Lucarelli, his sons, Peter Jr. of Connecticut and Eugene Lucarelli of Arlington and the entire Lucarelli family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family on behalf of the entire City Council.
