To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$100,000.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Other Ordinary Maintenance Account from Free Cash. In order to assist formerly protected tenants who are threatened with displacement because of the end of rent control, the City is now establishing an emergency pool of funds that the Department of Human Services "New Lease" Program can access on behalf of tenants. The fund is intended to help at risk tenants make a smooth transition to stable tenancy in the absence of rent control by using funds to pay a portion of the up-front costs associated with the relocation of tenants to new apartments, including first month's rent, last month's rent, or moving costs.
